

THINGS YOU NEED TO KNOW!

*We hope you enjoy your stay on our property,
and we ask that you please observe the following rules:*

1. **Conserve water.** South Australia is the driest state, in the driest country in the world! Water provided is rainwater caught in tanks from the rooves of our buildings. Our annual rainfall for the area is about 450 millimetres. Keep showers to 3 minutes 😊
2. **Stay on marked tracks.** Our property is home to many different species of birds and wildlife, walking/access tracks have been made for guests to help preserve this native habitat. Tammar wallabies can be seen crossing the main entry track at dusk if you are quiet.
3. **Use designated beach access and NO jumping off sand dunes.** Our sand dunes house a fragile ecosystem that needs to be protected. Heavy traffic and jumping in the dunes are detrimental to the long-term sustainability of this ecosystem.
4. **Outdoor fires must be managed with caution.** Fire danger season is 1 November to 30 April. No outdoor fires are permitted on the property during this period. No outdoor fires are permitted on Total Fire Ban days and if signs are posted instructing that no fires are permitted on the property. Outdoor fires are only allowed in Campfire Buckets provided at the front of each cabin. If Campfire bucket is located at side of cabin - no outdoor fires are permitted.
5. **Consider other guests on the property.** Keep noise to a minimum and respect other guests privacy in and around the cabins, ensure Amenities Centre is kept neat and tidy as this is an area shared with other guests.
6. **Don't leave food scraps or rubbish lying around the property.** Use the waste and recycle bins provided in the cabin and near the Amenities Centre.
7. **Beware of nature's dangers.** There are snakes on the property. Also water activities are undertaken at your own risk. Refer to First Aid instructions for snake bites in Welcome folder located in the cabin and also in First Aid cabinet at Amenities Centre.
8. **Most importantly, have a great time!!** 😊 Feel free to sign the Guest Book located in the Amenities Centre.
